

KT100 CHECKMATE

Step 1

If you can see the suspected stain use the supplied dropper to remove a small amount of the liquid from the filled bottle and then wet the suspected stain with 2 to 3 drops of the liquid. If you can't see a stain but suspect one may be present simply wet the suspected area. Now allow the liquid to soak into the fabric and after the liquid has soaked into the stained area of the fabric proceed to step 2 immediately before the fabric has any chance to dry.

Step 2

Absorb the biological material from the garment and onto the test paper by holding the paper down on the wetted area for 60 seconds or until paper is fully wetted. Now turn paper over so that the side that was facing the stain is facing up and then set the paper aside to dry.

Step 3

Using the same dropper remove 10ml (2tsp) of the liquid from the same bottle and mix it with the contents of the bottle containing the small amount of powder. Shake for 60 seconds to mix completely.

Note: Look on the dropper and notice the "5ml" at the top. Fill the dropper to the 5 mark twice and place that liquid into the bottle containing the CheckMate reaction component.

Step 4

For the last step you must time yourself carefully. Don't guess. Use a timer or a watch with a second hand. The idea in this last part of the test is to saturate the entire paper all at once by placing 3 big drops of the mixed solution directly on the same area of the paper where you transferred the stain. As soon as you place the liquid onto the paper start looking at your watch. If semen is present you will see purple color START to appear almost instantly within 3 to 5 seconds and then developing into a very distinctive purple color by 15 seconds, which will then turn very dark purple after that. If the color does not begin to appear until after 15 seconds the test is negative and no traces of semen are present. Any red, yellow or even slightly purple coloring that appears after an extended time is also normal. Only semen can cause the instant color reaction and discoloration of the paper after 15 seconds is a negative test.

Men

Timing is very important when using the CheckMate Infidelity Test Kit. If you suspect your female partner of having sex with someone other than yourself you must make certain you have had NO sexual

intercourse with her for at least 7 days. The female body can continue to secrete small amounts of semen for up to 72 hours after unprotected sexual intercourse-so be sure you have had no relations with her for the specified time period of 7 days. Failure to follow these guidelines could possibly result in a false positive test result.

Women

Timing is the most important factor for the proper use of this product. For women using this test on a man you must consider things like masturbation and personal habits and hygiene. CheckMate is very easy to use. Just wait until the “right” time to do the test.

IMPORTANT

The two supplied kits are designed to perform 5 to 10 tests each. Use one test kit at a time. After mixing the liquid with the powder the resulting reaction component can be used for 3 days at normal room temperature. If you can store the mixed liquid in the refrigerator you can use it for up to 30 days. You may also want to cut the 5 papers in each package in half to achieve more tests.
